 Multisyllabic words can be built using a knowledge of word families and affixes. A root word cannot be broken down into smaller words. Root words can be extended with affixes (prefixes and suffixes). A prefix is added to the start of a word and a suffix to the end to make another word. Syllables are the beats in word: 'do' (one beat), 'do-ing' (two beats), 'un-do-ing' (three beats). Every syllable must contain a vowel or a 'y' (un-do-ing).
