(2) In a cafe, a sandwich costs £3.59 and an orange juice costs 89p, or you can buy both as a 'meal' for £3.95. How much do you save buying the meal rather than the two items separately?

(3) T-shirts cost £10.95 each. There is a special offer whereby you can buy two t-shirts for £15. How much money do you save through this offer?

(4) 'Total' is a word used in addition questions and 'take away' is a word used in subtraction questions. How many other words for addition and subtraction do you know. Challenge...Can you create a question using one of these words or a multi-step problem with more than one of these words.
