Albert Einstein

Albert Einstein was born on March 14th, 1879, in Ulm, a city in Germany (situated on the River Danube). At an early age, he moved with his family to Munich. His father - Hermann Einstein - had his own electronics company, which inspired young Albert's interest in science, and he enjoyed a happy childhood with his mother - Pauline - and his younger sister Maria, who was nicknamed Maja.

Einstein attended a strict grammar school in Germany, the Luitpold Gymnasium, but did not enjoy his time here. His behaviour was poor and he was even told by one of the teachers that he would "never amount to anything". However, his educational fortunes changed when he was moved to a school in Switzerland (The Cantonal School in Aarau). Here he met a Maths teacher, Max Talmud, who became his mentor and inspiration.



ALBERT EINSTEIN

Born: March 14th, 1879

Birthplace: Ulm, Germany

Parents: Hermann and Pauline Einstein

Siblings: Maria (Maja)

Famous For: His theory of relativity, $E=MC^2$

Courage: Einstein demonstrated courage when he strived for greatness despite being told by his teacher that he “would never amount to anything” and by his grandmother that he was “much too thick”. He also took a low paying job as a patent clerk to support his family when his father’s business went bankrupt.

Legacy: The legacy he has left on the world is his incredible theory of relativity, which he toiled over for seven years. His famous equation, $E=MC^2$, is known throughout the world.

Interesting Facts: Einstein had a speech difficulty as a child and failed his first attempt at the entry exam for college. A note about the secret to happiness that Einstein wrote in a hotel in Tokyo in 1922 sold recently for \$1.3million.
