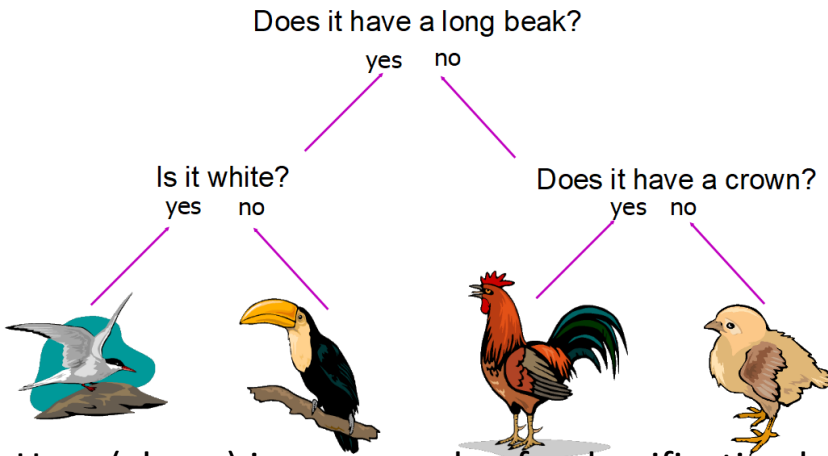


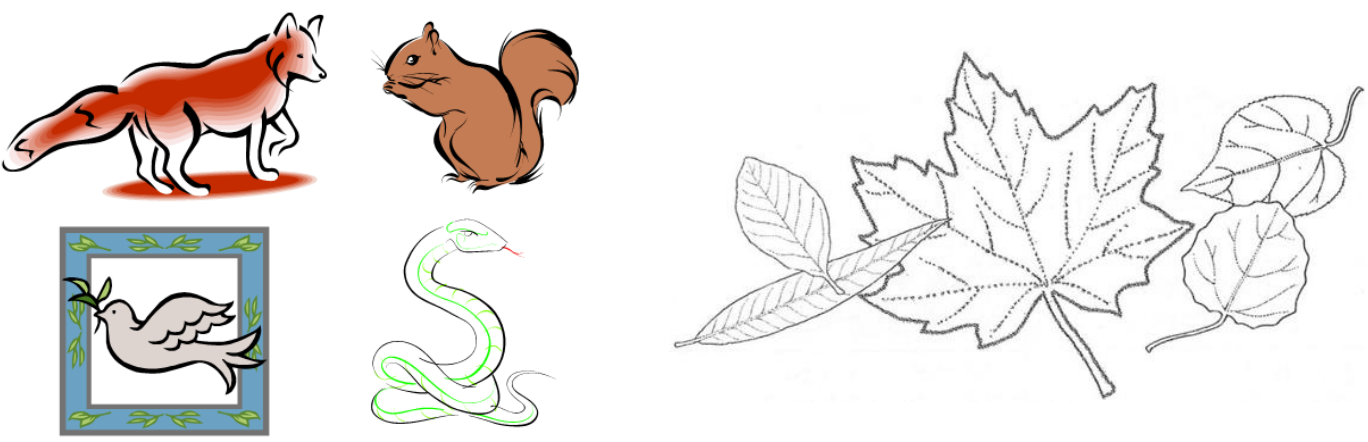
# Science Homework (to be completed in English Home Learning Books)
